Why Does God Give Us Instructions?

The Bible gives us 10 rules that God first gave to the Israelites that we still follow today (Exodus 20:1-17). These **instructions are called the 10 Commandments.**

And, why did God give us these instructions? Because He loves us!

Here are the 10 Commandments, in kid-friendly terms:

- 1. Put God FIRST in your life
- 2. Don't make idols (anything you put above God)
- 3. Don't misuse God's name
- 4. Keep God's day holy (holy means set apart)
- 5. Honor your mom and dad
- 6. Love your husband and wife
- 7. Don't kill
- 8. Don't steal
- 9. Don't lie
- 10. Don't want what isn't yours

You can point out to your kids that these rules have one theme in common – **they instruct us how to love!**
